#### INTRODUCTION

- 5. In what way would you like to be more like Jesus? Be specific!
- 6. Read <u>Ephesians 3:14-21</u>.
  - How is it possible to "know this love that surpasses knowledge?"
  - Do you find it difficult to grasp the vastness of Jesus's love and grace?
    What might make that difficult?
  - Take a few moments to pray for one another the prayer within this passage.

Go around your group and ask for prayer requests. Thank God for sending His Son to give the ultimate sacrifice, death on the cross and His resurrection. Pray that we would grow in our understanding of who Jesus is and that we become more and more like Him.
