INTRODUCTION

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. What has been your background or experience with the Holy Spirit?
- 2. The Holy Spirit is one of the most misunderstood things within Christianity. Why do you think that is? Why do some churches focus so strongly on the Holy Spirit while others almost never talk about the Holy Spirit at all?
- 3. Read <u>John 16:7-15</u>. In what ways does Jesus show how the Holy Spirit brings his Word to life?
- 4. Reread John 16:7 in different translations: <u>NIV</u>, <u>ESV</u>, <u>AMP</u>, <u>MSG</u>.
 - What are the different names used for the Holy Spirit?
 - Is there one that you most connect with or most helps you understand the role of the Holy Spirit in your life?
- 5. One of the words used to describe the Holy Spirit is "helper". What are some of the things in your life you would like help with?
- 6. How would you explain the Holy Spirit to a friend that is curious but lacks any spiritual background knowledge?
- 7. The Christian life is not about trying to do better but rather learning to trust in the work of the Holy Spirit. In what areas of your life do you sense the Holy Spirit asking you to trust him?

PRAYER

Go around your group and ask for prayer requests. Pray that we would grow in our understanding of the Holy Spirit and in turn grow in our relationship with Him.
