INTRODUCTION

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. What is God doing in your heart right now?
2. When you think about the end of the world (or the end of your own life) do you "feel fine?" If yes, how have you found this peace. If no, why not?
3. Read [Mark 1:14-15](#). What is meant by "the kingdom of God has come near?" What must we do to inherit the kingdom of God?
4. As followers of Jesus, we have access to heavenly ways here on earth through the power of the Holy Spirit working in us and through us. How have you experienced a piece of heaven on earth through the work of the Holy Spirit? How has this changed you?
5. When you think about the end, is there someone that comes to mind that your heart aches for? Read [Acts 1:7-8](#). Discuss with the group how the Holy Spirit might empower us with the courage and ability to reach people that do not know Jesus.

PRAYER

Go around your group and ask for prayer requests. As a group, spend time praying over each other. Check your HEART. Are you Hurting, Exhausted, Angry, Resentful, or Tense? Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal any of these areas and ask for help to take the necessary steps to find healing.
